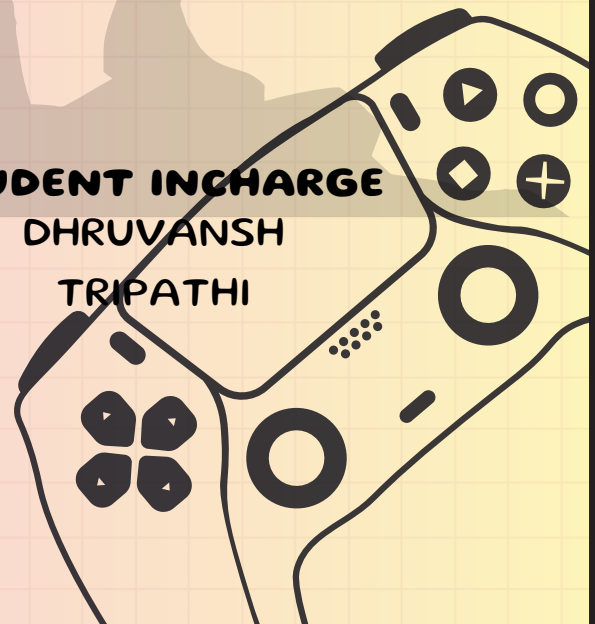

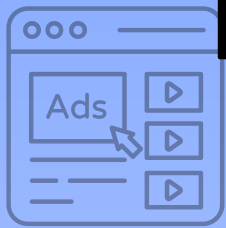

OVERVIEW

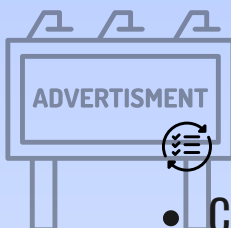

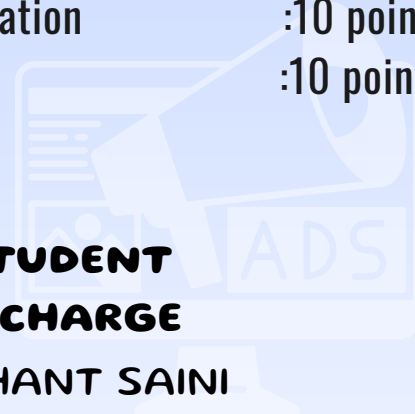
